All ETC-on-Film participants work towards learning specific skills while creating their films. These skills are laid out in the ETC-on-Film Badge Program. As skills are learned, badges are earned, and participants "level up" to the next badge. Learning these skills helps assure that each participant has met the same benchmarks along their journey of filmmaking and can confidently move on to the next level.
